

## 5 Days shoebills and Gorillas

This Uganda Unique Trip programme is meant for the true naturalist that feels like visiting some of the strange and Special species. The Mountain Gorillas and the Shoebills.

During our trip for 5 days shoebills and Gorillas in Uganda, does not only look at the species, the focus is on habitats and the Endangered species.



Here is the Outline of the Trip

Day 1:Arrival at Entebbe and overnight at the Hotel of the Choice and Budget.

Day 2:Transfer to Mabamba bay for the shoebill search and overnight.

Day 3:Road transfer to Bwindi Impenetrable Forest And Overnight.

Day 4:Gorilla tracking day and Relax.

Day 5:Departure back to Entebbe.

Day 1: Described, Upon arrival, depending on the likes of the Naturalist, there is a nearby Entebbe Botanical Gardens that can yield plenty of birds, of the 250 species that occurs in the Entebbe Botanical Gardens, Red-Faced Lovebird, Giant Kingfisher, Bat hawk, Orange weaver among others are some of the bird species you can expect on the 5 days. Shoebills and Gorillas. There are also some species of monkeys and reptiles present on the shores of 2<sup>nd</sup> Largest Fresh water Lake in the World, Lake Victoria.

Relax later after the photographic evening and overnight.

Day 2: Have an early morning breakfast and head out to the boat that connects Entebbe to the Ramsar site at Mabamba bay. Mabamba bay is named after the favourite food for the Shoebill, the (African Lung Fish). It's not only the shoebills and the Lung fish that lives there, but the Sitatungas and Black and white colobus monkeys, otters and lots of other birds like the Lesser jacana, Carruthers cisticola, White-backed Duck, Papyrus Gonorek, White Winged warbler for the keen birders.



Day 3: The trip of our 5 days shoebills and Gorillas commence by travelling to the pristine Montane Forest of Bwindi Impenetrable Forest and Overnight for another yet an exciting expedition in the Impenetrable Forest of Uganda. Depending on time of arrival, we can move out for a

nature walk to Looking for the Other unique wildlife like the Rwenzori three horned chameleons and Birds of the Albertine rift, on the Endemics list.

Day 4: The Most exciting part of the Tour to exhaust our 5 days shoebills and Gorillas. Have an Early breakfast and packed Lunches as we do not know how long the Gorilla tracking expedition will take, much as our target location is the most easiest of all the Localities in Uganda but in the wilderness, you never know. In most cases the Time on budget is always between 2 hours to 9 Hours, as hitting the 9<sup>th</sup> hour would be the apex of the Trip, on rare occasions it has happened.

Day 5: Road transfer to the Next destination as we conclude our 5 Days shoebills and Gorillas in Uganda.
